### Prize Claim Information for Winners:

Per the Lottery Bonus Zone Official Game Rules:

Each winner shall be sent up to three (3) emails with prize claim instructions. Because emails are sometimes not deliverable for reasons beyond the control of the Lottery and its administrators, each entrant should always check the WINNERS page on the New Jersey Lottery website after a second chance drawing to determine whether an entry has been selected as a prize winner. It may take up to seven (7) days for the winners list to be posted on the website.

Winners have fourteen (14) business days from the date the winners' list is posted on the New Jersey Lottery website to claim the prize. Prize winners will be notified in the manner and within the time specified. When registering for a VIP Club account, a Participant must include their name, street address, city, state, ZIP code, valid e-mail address, and valid contact telephone number. Failure to include any of this information, or failure to keep the information current, may result in a claim being denied. Return of any prize notification as undeliverable or failure to reply as specified in the notification (and within the time stated) may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner. Claims for prizes must be made in the manner and within the time specified on the notification. Failure to claim a prize within this time or in the manner specified may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner. Alternate winners are provided the same claim parameters as disclosed above.
